Dear College Student or Educator,

Thank you for your interest in our program. Accompanying this note is information on The Ohio State University's 2008 summer college curriculum offered at Stone Laboratory.

To apply, submit the enclosed Course Application, Liability and Photo Release forms (**do not submit any fees at this time**). An *Employment Application* and *Scholarship/REU Application* are also enclosed if you are interested. To help you in selecting a course, view detailed course descriptions on our website: www.stonelab.osu.edu.

General Requirements for

- *Upper-Level Courses (500 and 600)*: normally require 15 hours of biological sciences and junior rank or above by Summer 2008. (Some courses may have more specific prerequisites.)
- *Courses for Educators*: in-service teacher or education major with junior rank or above by Summer 2008
- *Introductory Courses*: completion of one course of high school biology

Upon acceptance of your application you will be sent a confirmation of course selection. In early April you will be sent a statement of fees due. Payment of room and meals fees will be due May 1*; tuition and lab fees will be due May 16. Upon receipt of the room and meals payment, you will be mailed an information packet from University Housing as well as information from Stone Lab regarding your arrival/stay at the Lab.

Note: \$75 of the room and meals payment is nonrefundable.

Costs

- **Tuition Fee**** depends on number of quarter credit hours, graduate or undergraduate credit, resident or nonresident status (see tuition chart on enclosed brochure).
- **Room and Meals** (see chart on enclosed brochure)
- **Laboratory Fee**, \$25 per course for most courses
- **Books and Supplies**, approximately \$30-\$150 depending on the number of courses taken (these may be purchased on the first day of class at the Laboratory).
- **OSU Transcript Fee** (optional) \$7 per transcript request.

**The room and meals fee will be due June 2 if you are enrolled in the Term 2 session.*

*** Stone Lab courses are based on the quarter credit hour system.*

Note: Students are required by OSU to have health insurance coverage; no exceptions.
